

General Rules for Participation.

1. The request for the participation of exhibitors accompanied by the person making the rent or the total amount according to the schedule this request.

2. To prepare the viewer gets allocated to it according to the area leased from (tickets and visit the exhibition and ID) and two days before the opening of the exhibition.

3. For the entry of exhibits foreign: There is a set of rules of customs and import to be followed in galleries built in the convention center where the customs office is limited, and not finish the customs procedures of the exhibits set out for display and return or sale of the speed and facilitate the transfer of exhibits from the access ports to the exhibition ground. For more information, please

contact the Department of Commerce Authority.

4. Exhibits exit / re-export: The re-export of exhibits that have not been disposed of by sale or distribution after the end of the show within a period not exceed the validity of the letter of guarantee provided to Customs. In the case of waiver of the period referred to customs rules apply on the neglected (an auction by the customs). For exhibits pure customs duties are charged 1% of the value according to the original bills.

5. For the national exhibits: exhibits is revealed to be accompanied by the entry copy of the minutes of receipt of the site and delivers at the gate of entry.

6. Help Security: The party responsible for the bar had its own all the property of their presence throughout the land of the Convention Center and shall take all precautions to secure their display and Decorated inside the showroom, as well as the provision of all means of fire insurance within the wing.

7. General observations: the right of the body that you photographed the wings and display areas as well as exhibits. In the case of the desire of the viewer in the distribution of brochures or posters advertising must obtain prior approval from the administration point of this.

8. There are some additional services (such as telephones, EE epidemiological additional loads, Internet 0.0000 etc.) and can identify these applications request to participate or submit a separate application to manage the booking, contracting and value paid by the performance of the service.

9. Refrain from participating: If the viewer wishes to withdraw before the opening of the exhibition duration of less than one month and a half without a reason acceptable to management forfeits his right to recover amounts previously paid to participate and become the prerogative of management without the need for an alert or warning. In case of acceptance of an apology before the date of the opening duration of less than a month and a half bidder shall bear 25% of the amounts outstanding. The notification shall be in writing to withdraw.

Rules and requirements for implementation of the decoration and presentation halls open:

10. Maximum height of the offer covered 5m.

11. Maximum load to the ground as follows: (a) 2000 kg/m 2 in Hall 5. (B) 1000 kg/m 2 in the halls 1-2-3-4.

(C) 300 kg/m 2 in the gallery and the remaining areas will not be allowed to skip this absolute weights.

12. Any wing height 2.5 m or more inside or outside the premises to provide: three copies of the maps on the 1:50 drawing size A3 models with specifications and clarify the terms of production. And detailed maps of the connections and geometric patterns of distribution boards and won the 3.2 map of the water connections, if any. Accounts and the establishment of the wing. Accounts of the establishment of the stairs and high areas, escalators, if any. A statement specifying the method of construction. And details of the establishment of the stairs, printing presses, its dimensions and Altarabzen with a graph. And details of any exhibits high risk. And details of the emergency exits and exit routes alternative. Interior and exterior. And engineering drawings to be delivered before the implementation of fifteen days for approval by the engineering department.

13. For wings with double ceiling must obtain a security certificate from a registered structural engineers at the end of construction

of the pavilion and in all cases before the opening of the exhibition.

14. The Commission has the right to request a change or reject any maps. The bidder is responsible for all the work mentioned above and will bear all expenses for calling the specialists from outside the body to check the wing and cables, and others. And will stop any acts contrary to what has been agreed upon.

15. Exhibitors are not entitled to claim any compensation if requested by the wing modification or suspension of its inception. Will be allowed after the approval of any changes to the maps submitted by the bidder for the Engineering Management.

16. When using flammable materials in the decoration and the coverage must provide two (2) a fire extinguisher under the supervision of the security wing of Industrial Authority.

17. Does not work any ingots or moon on the ground directly.

18. Ceramics are pasted on wooden pallets.

- 19. Taken not to close the roof in the decoration and the space left free for easy work with high efficiency air conditioning.
- 20. In the case of exhibitions organized externally loaded regulator any damage occur Active financially.
- 21. In the case of organizing the exhibition with exhibitors is the internal value of the damage financially.
- 22. Is to provide engineering drawings of the signage and how to install for approval before implementation.
- 23. Delivery of the site after the end of the exhibition situation, which was recognized it without any residue.
- 24. Committed to the viewer space allocated space and any increase in either decor or display will be accounted for.

It is worth recalling in this respect that the Islamic Centre for Development of Trade organises the Tourism Fair of the Member States of the Organisation of Islamic Conference once every two years in cooperation with a Member State in compliance with the resolutions and recommendations related to the field of economic and commercial cooperation among Member States.

The aim of this fair is to strengthen cooperation among Member States in the field of tourism. HISTORICAL BACKGROUND OF THE TOURISM FAIR OF THE MEMBER STATES OF THE ORGANISATION OF THE ISLAMIC CONFERENCE:

The second Tourism Fair is organised in compliance with the resolutions of the Summit Conferences and the Councils of the Ministers of Tourism, Trade and economy of the Member States of the Organisation of the Islamic Conference, especially the resolutions of the:

The 11th Islamic Summit Conference of the Member States of the Organisation of the Islamic Conference held in Dakar in March 2008;

The 24th Session of the Standing Committee for Economic and Commercial Cooperation (COMCEC) held in Istanbul in October 2008;

Islamic Conference of Tourism Ministers held in Damascus-Syrian Arab Republic in July 2008.

All these resolutions have laid stress on the importance of the tourism sector in the economic strategies of Member States as well as on their participation in this specialised fair, which is essential for the development of this vital sector.

It is worth recalling that the Islamic Centre for Development of Trade had already organised the First Tourism Fair from 24th to 26th November 2005 in Istanbul-Republic of Turkey. This event was crowned with a great success since it was attended by many Member States and 350 economic operators from tourism related sectors.

PARTICIPANTS IN THE FAIR:

The second Tourism Fair of the Member States of the Organisation of the Islamic Conference is open to the participation of all the Member States of the Organisation of the Islamic Conference and its organs and institutions in charge of promoting and developing tourism as well as various public and private tourism operators.

Countries enjoying the status of Observer in the Organisation of the Islamic Conference as well as tourism operators and bodies of the Muslim minorities in non OIC Member States may also participate in this event. International tourism companies may also take part in the fair through their branches in the Member States of the Organisation of the Islamic conference.

In addition to the participation of the relevant bodies and authorities in the field of tourism in Member states, this fair is also open to the participation of travel companies, tour operators, hotels and tourist resorts and Real Estate companies in addition to tourism services providers, handi crafters and tradesmen. The participation of investors will contribute to the success of this event.

EXHIBITS:

All marketable products and services related to tourism encompassing tourist destinations, hotel industry, all kinds of transports, travel agencies and hotel equipment as well as all tourism related activities that are compliant with the Islamic Shariah and principles.

PARTICIPATION CONDITIONS AND REQUIREMENTS:

Organisers provide incentives under the form of tariff and non tariff facilities for the entry of goods and persons. In this respect, facilities will be granted in the fields of transport, freight and shipping, accommodation, and customs clearance.
